Abstracts must be written in English. The end deadline for paper summaries is June 30, 2006. Authors should conform to guidelines for paper summaries and the sample format. General instructions are:

- Word files, Times New Roman 12, single space, justified.
- No more than one A4 size page, 2.5 cm margins (300 words).
- No paragraphs, figures or references.
- If more than one author, please underline the name of the lecturer.

Authors will propose oral or poster presentation for each work. The organizing committee will select a limited number of oral contributions (15 minutes) based upon relevance to the program. The remaining contributions will be presented as posters.
